



VRIPACK

Vripack’s design for the 42.09m *E&E* marries the robustness of an explorer with the elegance of a superyacht. Built by Cizgi Yacht in Turkey, she has conserved the remarkable seagoing comfort and smooth layout of her predecessor *Jasmin* - designed by Vripack for the same owners - while having a softer and more mature look. Vripack sketched over 100 critical details for the yard to make sure that the refinement of the design would be fully apparent in the outstanding end product.

E&E’s hull has profited from multiple in-house CFD studies and the most extensive still water and seakeeping model tests ever performed at Vripack - testing, analysing, optimising and retesting took almost two weeks in the basin. The outcome was a final construction weight that was on target practically by the kilogram, which in turn has resulted in fuel consumption of a mere 65 litres per hour at 11.8 knots. This proves that conventional yachts can be genuinely economical when designed with the right expertise and attention.
